**Course Outline**

The course is aimed at practicing electricians who wish to update their knowledge of the IEE wiring regulations.

**Course Content**

The course identifies changes in the regulations. It covers the structure of BS7671.

**Assessment**

Assessment is by an external City & Guilds paper. The “On-Line” examination lasts 2 hours and takes the form of multiple-choice questions.

**Entry Requirements**

Applicants should have

- A good understanding of electrical installation requirements and practices.
- A City & Guilds 2330 Level 2 (and preferably Level 3) or C & G 2360 Part 1 (and preferably Part 2)
- Their own copies of the BS7671 Wiring Regulations and the On-Site Guide
