Assessment

This is carried out by the College in the form of practical assessments and by City and Guilds in the form of a short answer written paper.

Entry Requirements

Candidates should:

- Have a good understanding of BS7671, I.E.E. 17th Edition Wiring Regulations
- Be in possession of either: City & Guilds 2360 Part 1 and Part 2, or City and Guilds 2330 Level 2 and Level 3
