# Construction Plant Maintenance Apprenticeship - Level 2

Course Duration: Two years consisting of 15 weeks in year one and 14 weeks in year two. Total of 29 weeks at 30 hours per week divided into 2 and 3 week blocks spread throughout the year

Part time Work based

## The Apprenticeship Framework

### Course Content – Year 1

- Health & Safety
- Workshop practice/manual skills/planning
- General servicing
- Engines
- Fuel systems
- Braking systems
- Steering
- Vehicle electrics
- Key skills

### Typical weekly timetable – year 1

- Two full days practical working on plant equipment
- Half a day machine shop bench fitting practical
- Half day key skills and NVQ portfolio building
- Two full days underpinning knowledge

### Course Content – Year 2

- Transmissions
- Hydraulics
- Pneumatics
- Wheels, tracks and suspension
- Wire ropes and lifting tackle
- Welding
- Vehicle electrics
- Key skills

### Typical weekly timetable – year 2

- Two full days practical working on plant equipment
- Half a day welding practical
- Half day key skills and NVQ portfolio building
- Two full days underpinning knowledge

The apprentice is encouraged to progress to an Advanced Apprenticeship Framework on completion of year 2

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#### Funding

Candidates aged between 16 and 18 will be eligible for free registration and training

Candidates aged 19+ before 31 August 2009 will be eligible for free training.

Registration, examination and certification fees would be charged at £250 per candidate

Accommodation, meal allowances, travel expenses and wages are the responsibility of the employer and apprentice candidate
