Course Outline

The course aims to give the student a thorough knowledge of the theory and practice of body massage. The successful student will be awarded a nationally recognised qualification. Home study essential.

- Client treatments

Assessment

A portfolio of evidence will be collected by the student for assessment. This will consist of written, oral and observed practical evidence. Independent assessments set by awarding body.

Entry Requirements

- Applicants should preferably be over 18 years of age
- Diploma in Anatomy & Physiology and D1120 must be studied alongside or previously gained
