Course Outline

The course aims to give the student a knowledge of anatomy and physiology to apply to practical therapies. Home study is **essential**.

Course Content

- Skeleton and joints
- Blood and lymphatic systems
- Muscles and nervous system
- Skin and hair
- Digestive and excretory systems
- Respiratory and olfactory systems
- Endocrine and reproductive systems

All the above are subject to VTCT amendments.

Assessment

A portfolio of evidence will be collected, which will consist of written assignment, oral and written tests. Independent assessment set by awarding body.

Entry Requirements

To be studied alongside all main therapies. Some students **may find it beneficial** to study prior to enrolling on therapy courses.
